Iconic names such as St Valery, Riechswald, Normandy, Tobruk, El Alamein, the invasion of Sicily, Monte Cassino and Burma come to mind.

During the Korean War, the Regiment won further honors at the Battle of the Hook. The Black Watch has since been involved in peacekeeping and counter-insurgency operations in various parts of the world; from the Mau Mau Uprising in Kenya to critical peacekeeping roles in Cyprus. It was in Northern Ireland from the beginning until after peace was declared. It served in Kosovo in 2001. It gained the Battle honour Iraq in 2003 and Al Basrah which is the last battle honour to be awarded to a Scottish Regiment. In tribute to its great valour, members of The Black Watch have been awarded 14 Victoria Crosses. It was indeed most proper that The Black Watch was the last British military unit to leave Hong Kong as it played a prominent role in the moving 1997 hand over ceremony.
